Adult Christian Education by Fr. Tom

Hello! April brings Happy Easter this year, and in Lectionary Year B we are reading more or less through Luke's book of the Acts of the Apostles. As it also so happens, this year we Episcopalians are plowing together through The Good Book Club, which during Lent had us reading the Gospel according to Luke; and now through the Easter Season we are reading Luke's sequel, the Acts of the Apostles together churchwide.

In our Adult Sunday School Class, I like our discussion to relate to the lectionary readings for the day, generally most often focusing on the gospel reading. But seeing that both the lectionary and TGBC are in Acts, we're going to do that also with the Sunday School class. IDK, with all the Bible study and Sunday school classes I've led over the years, this may be my first time leading a study of Acts. So it will be enlightening for all of us, with me learning more than everyone else combined. Remember: 9:15 to 10:15, between Sunday services, in the Mary Stuart Poole Library: the single-story building at the other end of the brick road, just beyond the pond, through the double doors. All are invited and welcome. Come late, come early, come on time, come just as you are, but come!!

The Good Book Club will continue through April and May until, celebrating the Easter Season, we've finished the entire book of Acts. Although I will not be writing extensive comments and with pictures and art for each day as I did for Luke during Lent, the readings will continue to be distributed by email daily or weekly, and any additional comments that I have may be published in my personal daily +Time blog <u>plusmoretime.com</u>
