Entering July, we are still considering our options for Children's Church in the fall. The wonderful Judy Bennett is "retiring" and leaving huge shoes to fill. All who are involved in Children's Ministry cannot thank Judy enough for her contributions to Children's Church. Her thoughtfully prepared lessons and related crafts and activities can be implemented easily by our teachers, and core concepts are informative and enjoyable for the children. For me personally, I will miss her company as we have worked together pondering what is best for our children. I shall, however, continue to seek her opinion and advice on matters spiritual...for Children's Ministry and for myself as well. (Proverbs?)

By informally surveying some of the parents and children, I gather that Godly Play, as presented by Liz Ward, has been very well received and is probably the preferred choice...a no-brainer if we had ten Liz Wards. But, Godly Play is designed to be delivered in hour-long increments using Montessori educational techniques. We must determine how to divide the lessons to fit Children's Church time parameters and not lose the spiritual "wondering" that is the essence of Godly Play. Implementation would also require greater effort and deep commitment from those willing and qualified to teach. (Judy Bennett has spoiled us.) Liz has the training to begin teaching others. Florencia Pereira and Anna Eberhard have attended authorized classes and understand the application of Montessori instruction and, even more importantly, the underlying spiritual significance of the child's developing relationship with God.

If you believe that you could be suited for this opportunity for service or if you want more information, please call me (265-8033). I am hoping for enough devoted teachers to be involved that getting to teach your Godly Play lesson will be a joy for you. Ask Liz or Anna or Flo or Alice Allen or Lindsey Crelling or anyone who has visited the "class" in action. I hope to hear from many of you.

If you have any questions or would like to volunteer to help with dinner prep or clean-up, please contact Mike Harding at 774-1955 or mharding@mmitv.com.




