Timed every year to coincide with and finish before our bishop's annual visit, this time on Wednesday, January 10, 2018, our Annual Inquirers' Seminar, sometimes also called Confirmation Class, will begin Sunday, November 5th in Mary Stuart Poole Library (single-story building with double-doors at the east end of the brick road), 9:15 to 10:15 a.m. between services, during regular Adult Sunday School time. I've been teaching these classes for thirty-some years, I've never saved my format from last year, and each year's sessions are new and different. Everybody is invited and welcome, no registration needed, just get a cup of coffee and come on over; if you are late, no worries, everyone but me always comes in late anyway, and it's no problem and no interruption, this is your invitation, and you are welcome.

The sessions are also called Confirmation Class to encourage folks who are considering being confirmed by the bishop when he comes in January; but it's for everyone and anyone who would like to learn more about Holy Nativity and the Episcopal Church; our ministries, our history, our organization, our worship, what we believe as Anglican Christians, and how what we believe is meant to direct our daily life in Jesus Christ. There'll be a sermon-length lecture each week with time for questions and discussion. Probably, as in every course I've ever taught in church, middle school, college, and university graduate school, I will learn more than anyone.

On this first Sunday in November, the 5th, our Holy Nativity children can celebrate All Saints' Day by being a part of the opening procession into church as we present the ribbon streamers on which we have noted the names of some people who, we believe, qualify for sainthood. We will gather in Kids' Kingdom at 10:15 to line up for processing to the front of the church and stay there for the children's sermon before leaving for Children's Church.

Each Sunday and each Wednesday, we like to remind the children of where we are in "The Circle of the Church Year". Although our very American holiday of Thanksgiving is not a part of the Church Year (The "New World" was unknown to the early Christians when the church seasons evolved.), it fits perfectly as we look toward Advent and preparing for the birth of the Baby Jesus. We hope that for Thanksgiving Day, we will be able to identify and appreciate many more of our blessings and want to share them, especially during Advent. Please mark your calendars.

11/26 – On the last Sunday in November, the sign-up board for the Christmas Pageant will be placed in Battin Hall. If there are multiple requests for a single role, we will draw names. Please note that those with specific parts, for example the Narrators, Mary, Joseph, the Star of Bethlehem, Gabriel, Innkeepers, Kings, etc., must be able to attend practices. Parents, please let me know if you or your children have special requests, questions, or recommendations. Remember, we want to make these special occasions meaningful and memorable for our children.

12/3 - For the first Sunday of Advent, we will recognize the kindness and generosity of St. Nicholas with "A Morning with Saint Nicholas"

at 9:15. (Mr. Durgan has invited the children to sing a carol along with the Chancel Choir for the wonderful Lessons and Carols presentation so following the party and before church, we will go to practice with the grown-ups).

12/6, Wednesday - 6:30 - Lessons and Carols

12/10 – Pajama Sunday Wear pajamas to church! And bring pajamas to give to others...or maybe bring a cuddly stuffed animal or a nice book to read at bedtime.

12/17 – During Children's Church, fit costumes and practice songs for the Christmas Pageant.

12/20 – 1:30 or 3:30 (depending upon school dismissal time) – Pageant Practice in the church.

OR...if most of you prefer, we could stay **after church on Sunday 24**th and <u>try to finish</u> by 12:30. However, the children need to be back at the church in Battin Hall by 3:45. 12/25 Christmas Eve 4:00 (3:45 for us) – Our best sharing is through the Christmas Pageant on Christmas Eve for we will be telling the story of the greatest gift of all.
