THE GOOD BOOK AND TED

Join us each Wednesday during Lent for this year's Lenten series. As always, we'll gather for the 5:30 service, followed by soup suppers and programs for all ages beginning at 6:30. We begin by joining the Good Book Club as a group and follow with a series of TED talks to accompany our reading. TED talks are a nonprofit organization devoted to spreading ideas in the form of short, powerful talks. Each TED talk is a maximum of 18 minutes. An open forum discussion will follow.

February 21 – "**The Good Book Club**" facilitated by Father Tom. Join us as we join in a diocesan-wide program in partnership with Forward Movement reading the Gospel of Luke and the Book of Acts during the Lenten and Easter seasons.

February 28 – Forgiveness. "Looking For The Man Who Broke My Neck" Facilitated by Father Tom. Joshua Prager was 19 years old when a devastating bus accident left him a hemiplegic. He returned to Israel 20 years later to find the man who turned his world upside down. In this TED talk, Prager probes deep questions of nature, nurture, self-deception and forgiveness.

March 7 – "*My Year of Living Biblically*" In this TED talk, AJ Jacobs tries to live an entire year following every single rule in the Bible as literally as possible. Facilitated by Father Steve

March 14 – "*Normal is a Dryer Setting*" Join us as Debra Jenkins (a friend of Father Steve and Lori) explores her journey through success, philanthropy, and tragedy in an elusive quest to find "normal." Facilitated by Father Steve

Laundry Love Update from David Smith

I'm SO excited to announce that the parishes of Holy Nativity Episcopal and St. Andrews Episcopal are joining forces and combining resources together "officially".....in this ministry. St. Andrews has participated with Holy Nativity for several LL events in 2017, and actually hosted the December event on their own.

Earlier this year, I met with Rev Molly Payne-Hardin and others from St Andrews to discuss ideas and opportunities for collaboration. It was mutually decided that each parish could support this ministry by alternating as the "primary host" on the 4th Thursday of each month in 2018 from 5-7 PM at Wash Depot on 11th Street - who has graciously agreed to continue serving as our location partner. The one date exception we are aware of right now is November, which will be held on the 5th Thursday (the 29th) due to Thanksgiving holiday conflict.

During the "primary" hosts' assigned month, they / we will be responsible for bringing all the laundry supplies, quarters, volunteers, tables, food, etc., with the "partner" parish assisting in any way they can - by providing additional volunteers, quarters, food, and so on.

St. Andrews will kick off 2018 by hosting Laundry Love on Thursday, January 25th from 5-7 PM. Wash Depot will be signing up event participants in a similar fashion as they did during the last few events of 2017.

Adult Christian Education by Fr. Tom

Lent begins this month, February, and we have fun and intriguing plans for Adult Sunday School of our Christian education ministries. This year we will participate in the churchwide program of reading the Gospel according to Luke through Lent; and perhaps Luke's sequel The Acts of the Apostles through the Easter Season. The program includes daily readings, which I will provide both an online Bible link for those reading online, and an online text. For those who come to our Adult Sunday School class (9:15 Sunday mornings, between services, in the parish Library - - down the brick road), I will provide printed text in print large enough to be read comfortably by most folks, 13-pitch or 14-pitch type. And I will put a few extra copies of the daily print format on the small table at the back of the - - sanctuary - - to be picked up by anyone else who might like to DO these readings instead of Giving Up for Lent.

Again, during Lent, these readings from Luke for the week will be the subject of our Sunday School gatherings. Everyone is invited and welcome.

Plus, I will include the daily Luke readings in my daily blog, +Time. My blog is personal, not a parish ministry, but I will include at least a link to the daily Luke readings.
