The Lord's Supper, Communion, the Eucharist - there are many names for this sacrament, but even more theories as to what's actually going on and what its significance is. What Jesus meant when he said "This is my body" has been a point of speculation and contention among Christians for nearly 2,000 years. In this class we'll explore what the Bible has to say, early Christian belief and practice, the major theories in play during the Reformation, and what our Book of Common Prayer says (and doesn't say!) about this sacrament which is so central to our worship.
