#### Children's Ministry October 2020 by Beverly McDaniel

Welcome back to our children who are ready to resume Children's Time with Fr. Steve or Father Tom at the beginning of the 10:30 service, who want to attend Children's Church, who are eager to come for Wonderful Wednesdays with Club 456, some Godly Play, and the cleanest nursery ever. It is apparent to everyone who worships with us, our parishioners and our visitors as well, that Holy Nativity is a church that welcomes and cherishes our children. We take very seriously our responsibility to protect our children and their families, therefore we have adjusted the Children's Ministry programs according to the counsel of the Bay County Health Department and the Florida Department of Health, both of which recommended following the protocol published by the CDC. Please help us and the children adhere to these safeguards.

For children attending school, wearing masks seems to be routine. They will need to wear them on Sunday when they go up for Children's Time and also for Children's Church which will be held in the Godly Play room or spread into Battin Hall if necessary for social distancing. The children, 3<sup>rd</sup> grade and below, will gather, masked, in Kids' Kingdom for stories and activities drawn from the lectionary using the Children's Bulletins you may have seen that match the gospel that is read in church. See if you can make a connection with what you heard and your child's lesson.

Kaew Sumpton and I have been worried about the nursery staffing and training in protocol standards for our wonderful nursery volunteers, then I received a phone call and an answered prayer for Kaew and me. Emily Brock, known to most of you from growing up in this church and also working in the nursery while in high school, has graduated early from college and is back at home beginning graduate school with on-line classes. She is great for this job in this situation. But do not go anywhere, beloved volunteers Sandy Ciccarelli, Kathy Brust, Katie Wattenbarger, and Teresa Durgan,

we will need you soon.

Sign-in for the nursery will be at the door closer to Kids' Kingdom to avoid congestion and with some screening questions and possibly noncontact temp checks. You can be confident that your little one will be in good hands which have been sanitizing toys, sorting toys for weekly rotation, moving out furniture, minimizing soft surfaces, and scrubbing rubber floor mats. To keep this space as hygienic as possible, we cannot let the older children come in the nursery to play anymore, at least while we are under the pandemic threat. Please explain to them that only little children, three and under, are allowed in the nursery for now.

Wonderful Wednesdays will reopen with The Blessing of the Pets at 6:00, October 7<sup>th</sup> in the Smith Pavilion with masks and social distancing for humans. There will not be programs for children or adults that evening, but the nursery will be open for infants and toddlers only. We do invite you to peep in; just please don't touch the toys. Children's programs resume on the following Wednesday from 6:30 – 7:30 after the 5:30 service and dinner. The nursery will be open for infants and toddlers. Holly Melzer will again lead the now expanded Club 456, who will meet, wearing their masks, in the two-story building in the room upstairs that they were working to decorate but never got to enjoy. Kindergarten and elementary programs are being designed and implemented according to attendance numbers and CDC recommendations. We are hoping to be able to offer Godly Play on Wednesdays at least twice a month. I will be calling on many of you to teach or assist or substitute or just stand-by to ensure we can adhere to proper procedures. This may be tedious, but we will grow accustomed to it, just as the children and their teachers are doing at school. Over everything, we love our children, and we will do whatever it takes to protect them and their families so that we can be together again at our church.

Please plan to wear a facemask as the new routine. We'll have extra masks there.

For anyone who doesn't have a study Bible, you are welcome to take one from our bookcase, they haven't been touched since last winter, and you may make it your own, take it home or mark it with your name and keep it in the classroom.

As I say, the way is unchartered, but it will be wonderful to have class again. Love to all!
