

Livestream Assistant


Everyone enjoys the livestream services, but help is needed maybe once a month. Training provided and recognition in the weekly bulletin!


Souper Bowl Sunday promises to be a fun way to show support for your team and for the Backpack Ministry. No limit to the number of cans that you can contribute!
