From Father Tom

Dearest friends and neighbors! A couple of years ago, Father Steve and I talked about my easing slowly into retirement of some sort. At the Time, I was teaching the adult Sunday school class every Sunday morning, attending both Sunday services 8:00 and 10:30 as assisting priest (usually the Celebrant at eight o'clock), preaching the sermon at both services about one Sunday in three or four, and filling in as what clergy call "Supply Priest" when Father Steve is away. He suggested that I begin easing off by first retiring from teaching the adult Sunday school class (which Doctor Dan has graciously taken on), and then by changing my Sunday schedule to stop coming to assist at 8:00 and only assist at 10:30. But that I continue in my primary ministry of Priest Associate by staying on the preaching schedule to continue preaching one Sunday in three or four; and also continue to fill in as Supply Priest when Father Steve is away. We worked into that change and it's been going well.

Several folks have asked me how Father Steve's upcoming retirement will affect me, and I want to answer that.

First, everyone on the parish staff works for the Rector and at the Rector's pleasure. In April 2009, when I was finishing up my five year stint as priest at St Thomas, Laguna Beach, Steve telephoned me and invited me to come back on staff at Holy Nativity. It would be my third Time back on staff as Priest Associate, and I happily accepted. We discussed and agreed what my responsibilities would be, and that's what I've been doing these years starting May 2009. My arrangement is with Father Steve, and when he retires (or before if he prefers), will be my last day on staff as Priest Associate. So, God, Rector, and my health willing, I intend and expect to be on HNEC staff until May 2024.

Second, Linda and I were part of the group of some ten founding families who, with the guidance of the bishop and our first priest, Fr David Damon, founded Holy Nativity Episcopal Church in 1955. We are founding members! This is our home parish. We don't intend to go anywhere, except that when Fr Steve retires I will retire to the pew with Linda - - I get the aisle seat in her pew. We are not making any plans beyond that; but in the possibility that our next rector may need help from Time to Time, maybe my health will still be such that I can still do that now and then. But as I say, we are not making any plans beyond my being in Linda's pew with her, as I continue to sing loud and off key.

Right Shoe First and Praise the Lord!
