Spring 2024 Confirmation Class. Our diocesan bishop will be here Sunday, May 12, 2024 for his annual visit, including Confirmation, our rite of welcoming folks who want to be Christians in the Episcopal Church. Our prayerbook (page 860) says "Confirmation is the rite in which we express a mature commitment to Christ, and receive strength from the Holy Spirit through prayer and the laying on of hands by a bishop" and goes on to say "It is required of those to be confirmed that they have been baptized, are sufficiently instructed in the Christian Faith, are penitent for their sins, and are ready to affirm their confession of Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord."

We offer two one-hour Sunday morning classes - - which we call "Episcopal 101" - - for those who may wish to be confirmed that day. The classes will be **Sunday morning, April 14** and **Sunday morning, April 21**, between Sunday morning services, 9:15 to 10:15. I will be conducting the classes. If you want to be confirmed, or are thinking about being confirmed, or just would enjoy learning more about being a Christian in the Episcopal Church, you are invited. <u>You will need to sign up ahead of time by emailing admin@holy-nativity.org</u>

Everyone enjoys the livestream services, but help is needed maybe once a month. Training provided and recognition in the weekly bulletin!


