I don't know of any priest who has had to opportunity to work with and serve such wonderful people. You are a unique parish in the very best sense, and Lori and I will miss you deeply.

But as I told you in my retirement announcement, while I knew this day would come, it doesn't make it any easier. I came here all those years ago, even when I wasn't sure it made sense personally, because I believed I was called to be here. And now I will leave you feeling that same sense of call. As the writer of Ecclesiastes tells us, "For everything there is a season." I believe I'm being called not only to a new season in my own life but that, you too, are being called to a new season in the life of this beloved parish.

Thank you seems so inadequate. But those are the words I want to leave you with that come from the bottom of our hearts. Thank you for being such a receptive place; receptive to new ideas, new ways, new facilities, and a new sense of just what a special place this is. Thank you for holding onto all the things that are a part of what makes that place so special. You care for, love, and enjoy each other in such wonderful and meaningful ways. And I have no doubt in my mind that ethos will never change. Thank you for believing it could be done even when it didn't seem like it. Thank you for your commitment to worship and our gatherings that make us a community of faith. Thank you for always coming together when there has been a need and responding in such gracious ways. Thank you for the care and love you've given to both Lori and me that was never taken for granted and always appreciated. Thank you for our going-away celebrations (with one still to come). They truly have been celebrations, and this wonderful parish has so much to celebrate. Thank you for all the gifts, notes, cards and well wishes over the years. They've all been so thoughtful. And, finally, thank you for being you. You are some of God's very best ideas and we are grateful to have been a part.

While we won't be present among you, please know that our gratitude, our prayers, and our love will never leave. And thanks be to God and to you for the honor of being your Rector. You will never fully know what it has meant in our lives.

Dear beloved Holy Nativity folks,

As I was wrapping up things to retire from my last church fifteen years ago, Father Steve phoned me and invited me to return to Holy Nativity as Priest Associate on staff part time, and I accepted happily, starting May 2009. It would be my third Time on staff here, working with three rectors, Without diminishing my enjoyment of the other churches I have served as priest, this Time back at HNEC, working with Father Steve, the folks on our church staff, and you, has been best of all, ranking up there with my years as Chaplain and religion teacher at Holy Nativity Episcopal School before Father Steve came!

My Time has come to retire, and my last Sunday will be May 19th, same as Steve's last day. I thank you for having me, and for welcoming me back each Time! You are a joy to serve with. I have loved being here, sharing pastoral ministries with Fr Steve, filling in as supply priest when he was away, serving as "summer priest" while he was on sabbatical, preaching regularly, and frequently standing behind the altar as celebrant. 


#### Shop BOGO...think Food Pantry!




#### Mid-Week Bible Study

#### the Bishop is coming, the Bishop is coming!

"Episcopal" is a New Testament Greek word that means overseer or "bishop" and we are called The Episcopal Church because the chief pastoral and administrative leadership in our church is through clergy ordained as bishops, who head geographical areas called "dioceses". Holy Nativity Episcopal Church is a parish of the Episcopal Diocese of

the Central Gulf Coast, with the bishop's headquarters office in Pensacola. It's the custom of the church for the bishop to come to each parish congregation each year for an annual pastoral visit, which includes time with the congregation, checking over official records including the attendance record book and the Parish Register of members and services, and meeting with clergy and vestry. The main event of this "Episcopal visit" is usually a worship service that includes the Rite of Confirmation. Here's what the Catechism says about that:

#### Q. What is Confirmation?

A. Confirmation is the rite in which we express a mature commitment to Christ, and receive strength from the Holy Spirit through prayer and the laying on of hands by a bishop.

Q. What is required of those to be confirmed?

A. It is required of those to be confirmed they they have been baptized, are sufficiently instructed in the Christian Faith, are penitent for their sins, and are ready to affirm their confession of Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord.

On our parish calendar for 2024, coming up this Spring on Sunday, May 12th, Holy Nativity will have our annual episcopal visit, with service of Confirmation for members who would like to be confirmed or received into the Episcopal Church by the bishop.
