

Children's Sunday School at 9:15am has been a great time learning and growing together in our faith. Mrs. Pereira's 3rd-5th graders have been studying Psalms and Mrs. Ward's K-2nd graders enjoyed a series called Pumpkins & Parables. We will look toward stories of thankfulness as we change themes in November. Parents, we would love to have your child/children join us for this time together! Did you know there is a Nursery provided during the Sunday School hour, for our youngest children, so the grown ups can attend their own Sunday School in the Library with Dr. Dan?! We love parent volunteers, but you do no have to have a child participating in Children's Ministries to volunteer! We love having church members of all ages assist and show the children that we are all here to love and worship the Lord together!
